**Shoulder Sleeve Insignia. Description:** A white oval edged with a 1/8 inch (.32 cm) red border 2 inches (5.08 cm) in width and 2 1/2 inches (6.35 cm) in height overall consisting of two blue wavy bars in base, below a green palm wreath, surmounted by a black pike spear, point up, rising from base throughout.

**Symbolism:** Red, white and blue are the national colors. The blue wavy bars allude to the Tigris and Euphrates Rivers and Iraq's title of "the land of two rivers," the area of operation. The black pike spear represents military readiness and might. The palm wreath highlights the service of the Multi-National Corps and soldiers, in Iraq.

**Background:** The shoulder sleeve insignia was approved on 14 January 2005. (TIOH Dwg. No. A-1-863)

**COMBAT SERVICE IDENTIFICATION BADGE:** A silver color metal and enamel device 2 inches (5.08 cm) in height consisting of a design similar to the shoulder sleeve insignia.

**Distinctive Unit Insignia. Description:** A Silver color metal and enamel device 1 1/8 inches (2.86 cm) in height blazoned as follows: Argent (Silver Gray), in base two wavy bars Azure below a palm wreath Proper, overall issuing from base a pike spear Sable, point up.

**Symbolism:** The red border indicates distinction and valor. The blue wavy bars allude to the Tigris and Euphrates Rivers and Iraq's title of "the land of two rivers," the area of operation. The black pike spear represents military readiness and might. The palm wreath highlights the service of the Multi-National Corp and soldiers, in Iraq.

**Background:** The distinctive unit insignia was approved on 14 January 2005.
